

**SUMMARY OF RESOLUTIONS  
VILLAGE OF SUNBURY FOR CALENDAR  
YEAR 2014**

<b>RESOLUTION 2014-01</b>	A Resolution authorizing public advertisement requesting bids for provision of refuse collection services for single family residences within the Village of Sunbury pursuant to O.R.C 731.141 and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-02</b>	A Resolution authorizing the execution of a third addendum to the Village of Sunbury and Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. refuse collection service agreement to extend the current agreement for a period of one year through March 31, 2015 to coincide with the potential future cooperative agreement with no rate increase to the Village of Sunbury residents and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-03</b>	A Resolution rescinding prior resolution 2014-01 authorizing a public advertisement requesting bids for provision of refuse collection services and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-04</b>	A Resolution appointing Dave Martin and Tommy Hatfield as representatives to the Delaware County Tax Incentive Review Council and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-05</b>	A Resolution as required by O.R.C. 709.023(C) setting forth municipal services, including sewer, police, zoning, streets and roadways that will be provided to ±128.285 Acres of land in Berkshire Township (Delaware County) Ohio if annexed to the Village of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency.

<b>RESOLUTION 2014-06</b>	A Resolution as required by O.R.C. 709.023(C) setting forth municipal services including sanitary sewer, police, zoning, streets and roadways, and storm water management and floodplain that will be provided to ±183.912 Acres of land in Berkshire Township (Delaware County) Ohio if annexed to the Village of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-07</b>	A Resolution adopting the Delaware County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and agreeing to plan implementation contingent upon resource availability including necessary funding and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-08</b>	A Resolution pursuant to O.R.C. 5705.34 accepting the amounts and tax rates as determined by the Budget Commission of Delaware County and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-09</b>	A Resolution required by O.R.C. 709.023(C) setting forth municipal services including sewer, police, zoning, streets and roadways that will be Provided to 247.471 acres of land in Berkshire Township (Delaware County) Ohio if annexed to the Village of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-10</b>	A Resolution authorizing the Village Administrator to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program(s) to apply for financial assistance in connection with the 2015 Village of Sunbury street improvements and to execute contracts, with the recommendation of the Village Council Engineer and approval by the Village Solicitor, as required and declaring an emergency.

<p><b>RESOLUTION 2014-11</b></p>	<p>A Resolution authorizing the Village Fiscal Officer to expend funds in the amount of \$85,500 from the Impact Fees/ Municipal Fund to purchase, restore, and develop real property located at the southwest corner of Cherry Street and Columbus Street for creation of additional parking for municipal facilities and declaring an emergency.</p>
<p><b>RESOLUTION 2014-12</b></p>	<p>A Resolution authorizing execution of electric purchase contract with Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. dba I.E.S. Energy for provision of electrical energy for Village of Sunbury municipal facilities only for a three year period conditional upon final legal approval and declaring an emergency.</p>
<p><b>RESOLUTION 2014-13</b></p>	<p>A Resolution rescinding Resolution 2012-14 which authorized the transfer from the General Fund to the Cemetery Fund in the amount of seven thousand five hundred forty-two dollars (\$7,542) and ordering said funds transferred back to the Cemetery Fund from the General Fund.</p>
<p><b>RESOLUTION 2014-14</b></p>	<p>A Resolution rescinding Resolution 2012-13 which authorized the transfer of the balance of seven thousand five hundred forty two dollars (\$7,542) from the Cemetery Bequest Fund to the General Fund pursuant to ORC 5705.14(D) and ordering said funds transferred back to the Cemetery Bequest Fund.</p>
<p><b>RESOLUTION 2014-15</b></p>	<p>A Resolution accepting “then and now” purchase order to Squire Patton Boggs for legal services in the amount of \$15,087.50 and declaring an emergency.</p>
<p><b>RESOLUTION 2014-16</b></p>	<p>A Resolution authorizing the Village Fiscal Officer to expend \$11,759.33 from Police Impact Fees to purchase modular battery radar and surveillance video camera and declaring an</p>

	emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-17</b>	A Resolution as required by O.R.C. 709.023(C) setting forth municipal services including sewer, police, zoning, streets and roadways that will be provided to 250.632 acres of land in Berkshire Township (Delaware County) Ohio if annexed to the Village of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency.
<b>RESOLUTION 2014-18</b>	A Resolution authorizing public advertisement requesting bids for provision of refuse collection services for single family residences within the Village of Sunbury subject to final administrative and legal approval and declaring an emergency.
