<b>Ordinance 2017-01</b>	An Ordinance setting the 2017 Annual Appropriations
<b>Ordinance 2017-02</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute a renewal agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Wildlife for provision of a Fisheries Management Program at the Village of Sunbury Upground Reservoirs
<b>Ordinance 2017-03</b>	An Ordinance amending Sunbury Codified Ordinance 351.16 to prohibit parking along Heartland Meadows Drive adjacent to General Rosecrans Elementary School from South Miller Drive to Southworth Drive on both sides of the road
<b>Ordinance 2017-04</b>	An Ordinance amending the rules and regulations of the Village Of Sunbury Cemetery aka Sunbury Memorial Park to provide for increased foundation costs
<b>Ordinance 2017-05</b>	An Ordinance amending the rules and regulations of the Village of Sunbury Cemetery aka Sunbury Memorial Park to allow minimum headstone foundation costs to be determined administratively in accordance with market rates

<b>Ordinance 2017-07</b>	An Ordinance amending Ordinances 2004-20, 2007-21, And 2009-33 and Sunbury Codified Ordinance 123.05 to designate the Interim Chief of Police and the Mayor as backup signators in the absence of the Chief of Police on all purchase orders under \$4,000 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-08</b>	An Ordinance re-appointing two members to the Board of Trustees of the New Community Authority known as Northgate NCA I pursuant to ORC 349.04 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-09</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the execution of a Governmental Aggregation Services Agreement with Volunteer Energy Services, Inc. for provision

	of retail natural gas services for the Village of Sunbury and participating residents and businesses for a two-year period commencing June 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2017 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-10</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of a police cruiser for a sum not to exceed \$34,554 from Coughlin Ford Inc. and further authorizing the execution of all documents associated therewith and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-11</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of law enforcement outfitting package for a new police cruiser from Parr Public Safety for a sum not to exceed \$16,534.61 and authorizing the execution of all documents associated therewith and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-12</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of a replacement on-officer video camera system and associated service agreement from Taser International for the Village of Sunbury Police Department
<b>Ordinance 2017-13</b>	An Ordinance approving amendments to the Village of Sunbury Zoning Code regarding lot coverage requirements
<b>Ordinance 2017-14</b>	An Ordinance ratifying to the appointment of Robert E. Howard as Chief of Police for the Village of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-15</b>	An Ordinance waiving the residency requirement for Robert E. Howard during his tenure as Chief of Police for the Village of Sunbury and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-16</b>	An Ordinance approving the editing and inclusion of certain Ordinances as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-17</b>	An Ordinance approving a Memorandum of Understanding Sewer Agreement between the Village of Sunbury, Ohio, Northgate NCA I and Northgate Land Company I, LLC
<b>Ordinance 2017-18</b>	An Ordinance approving the application for a Dairy Queen Restaurant to be located in an out lot in the Sunbury Mills Plaza

<b>Ordinance 2017-19</b>	An Ordinance providing for the employment of David J. Brehm as Village Solicitor for a two year term commencing September 3, 2017
<b>Ordinance 2017-20</b>	An Ordinance establishing a reduced speed limit of 25 mph on Miller Drive between the intersection with State Route 37 and New 3C Highway per ORC 4511.21 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-21</b>	An Ordinance approving amendments to the Village of Sunbury Zoning Code Regarding Lot Density Requirements in Planned Residence District (PRD) and Planned Single Family District (PSFD)
<b>Ordinance 2017-22</b>	An Ordinance establishing a reduced speed limit of 50 mph on State Route 3-C Highway within the municipal limits of The Village of Sunbury per Orc 4511.21
<b>Ordinance 2017-23</b>	An Ordinance approving the construction improvement plans for Sunbury Meadows Section 12 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-24</b>	An Ordinance approving the application of Pulte Homes of Ohio LLC to approve a modification of the approved development plan for nine selected lots within The Sunbury Meadows Subdivision Section 9 to allow increased lot coverage of 30% vs 25% and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-25</b>	An Ordinance approving the construction improvement plans and final plat for Sunbury Meadows Section 13 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-26</b>	An Ordinance amending Ordinance 2017-23 to indicate approval of the final plat for Sunbury Meadows Section 12 and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-27</b>	An Ordinance awarding the contract for the 2017 Village Street Improvements to American Pavements, Inc. pursuant to their lowest and best bid and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-28</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of a dump truck outfitted with a snowplow pursuant to ORC 125.04(c) for a sum not to exceed \$86,377.75 and further authorizing the execution of all documents associated therewith and declaring an emergency

<b>Ordinance 2017-29</b>	An Ordinance approving a development agreement between the Village of Sunbury, the State of Ohio Department of Transportation, Northgate Land Company I LLC, and Northgate NCA I regarding the proposed improved interchange at I-71 and Routes 36/37 and the proposed Sunbury Parkway and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-30</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of a police cruiser from Lebanon Ford for a sum not to exceed thirty two thousand two hundred forty nine (\$32,249.00) dollars pursuant to state bid pricing and further authorizing the execution of all necessary documents
<b>Ordinance 2017-31</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of law enforcement outfitting package for a new police cruiser from Parr Public Safety Equipment for a sum not to exceed sixteen-thousand six hundred and seventy-four and 61/100 (\$16,674.61) dollars and authorizing the execution of all necessary documents
<b>Ordinance 2017-32</b>	An Ordinance ratifying and approving the 2013 Residential Code of Ohio and subsequent updates as promulgated by the State of Ohio Board of Building Standards as the residential building code for the Village of Sunbury and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-33</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the mayor to enter into an employment contract addendum with Allen E. Rothermel as Village Administrator and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-34</b>	An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an employment contract second addendum with Kathy Belcher as Village Fiscal Officer and declaring an emergency
<b>Ordinance 2017-35</b>	An Ordinance approving recommended updates made by the Ohio General Assembly affecting Chapter 182 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Sunbury, Ohio regarding Municipal Income Tax
<b>Ordinance 2017-38</b>	An Ordinance approving the purchase of software upgrades from CIVICA CMI at a cost of \$70,751 and declaring an emergency

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
