

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF SUNBURY FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2012

<p>Ordinance 2012-01</p>	<p>An Ordinance setting the 2012 annual appropriations agreeing to expenditures in calendar year 2012 pursuant to applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code.</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-02</p>	<p>An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of notes in the maximum principal amount of \$2,457,100 in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying the costs of (I) improving and reconstructing the intersection of Morning Street and Cherry Street, (II) acquiring real estate for park purposes, (III) constructing the Granville Street Extension Bridge; (IV) improving municipal streets and parking lots in proximity to Town Hall Square, (V) the Village's portion of the cost of improving public streets and easements by improving U.S. Route 36/State Route 37 and Kintner Parkway and (VI) improving the vehicular transportation system in the Village.</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-03</p>	<p>An Ordinance ratifying the prior actions of Sunbury Village Council finding construction of the Village of Sunbury Wastewater Treatment Plant Chemical Building to be a real and present emergency pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 735.051 to allow completion by Ohio EPA 6/1/2012 deadline and declaring an emergency.</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-04</p>	<p>An Ordinance awarding the contract for the Village of Sunbury Wastewater Treatment Plant precast building to Carr Concrete Corporation pursuant to their lowest and best bid of Thirty-two Thousand Four Hundred Fifty (\$32,450.00) Dollars and declaring an emergency.</p>

Ordinance 2012-05	An Ordinance authorizing the execution of a group contract with Medical Mutual of Ohio for provision of medical insurance commencing February 1, 2012 for Village of Sunbury employees and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2012-06	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of two police cruisers pursuant to O.R.C. 125.04(C) for the sum of Twenty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Four (\$22,844.00) Dollars each and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2012-07	An Ordinance authorizing an execution of a lease of approximately 9 acres of real estate located at Freedom Park for grain farming purposes pursuant to O.R.C. 721.03 pursuant to the highest and best bid of Eight One and 50/100 (\$81.50) per acre and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2012-08	An Ordinance approving the execution of a Third Addendum to the Parkland Construction and Utility Construction, Extension, Service and Development Agreement with Dominion Homes, Inc. reducing pre-paid sewer taps to be purchased from 75 taps per year to 50 taps per year paid bi-annually with a total number of taps purchased to remain the same.
Ordinance 2012-09	An Ordinance approving the application of Geoffrey E. Albrecht, Trustee of the Stephen P. Haban Trust to rezone approximately 1.509 acres more or less from Industrial District to Commercial District (C-2) pursuant to the Village of Sunbury Zoning Code and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 2012-10	An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute a contract for planning services between the Village of Sunbury and the Delaware County Regional Planning Commission for provision of a comprehensive plan at a cost not to exceed Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars.
Ordinance 2012-11	An Ordinance authorizing the execution of a mutual aid agreement between the Village of Sunbury and various political subdivisions in Delaware County to provide emergency police protection services and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2012-12	An Ordinance approving the editing and inclusion of certain ordinances as parts of the various components codes of the Codified Ordinance of Sunbury, Ohio and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2012-13	An Ordinance amending the restricted hours contained in Ordinance 2010-20 and Ordinance 2011-12 which prohibited all right hand turn movements at red traffic control signals during restricted hours at the intersection of State Route 37/U.S. 36 (Cherry Street) and North and South Miller Drive to be consistent with revised 2012-2013 school hours and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2012-14	An Ordinance amending the restricted hours contained in Ordinance 2010-22 and Ordinance 2011-13 which prohibited all right hand turn movements at red traffic control signals during restricted hours at the intersection of Heartland Meadows Drive and S. Miller Drive and at the intersection of State Route 3C Highway and S. Miller Drive/Granville Street to be consistent with revised 2012-2013 school hours and declaring an emergency.

<p>Ordinance 2012-15</p>	<p>An Ordinance approving the application for plan review and zoning certificate of AutoZone Development Corporation contingent upon final engineering approval and declaring an emergency,</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-16</p>	<p>An Ordinance approving amendments to the Village of Sunbury Zoning Code including revisions involving site plans, minor lot line adjustments, zoning certificates, open space requirement, portable storage containers, planned residential districts, lighting provisions, parking requirements, street tree planting, tree preservation, sidewalks, signage and other miscellaneous revisions.</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-17</p>	<p>An Ordinance adopting the Village of Sunbury natural gas aggregation program plan of operation and governance pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4929.26 entitled “Governmental Aggregation Program Agreement Between Village of Sunbury and Volunteer Energy Services, Inc.” and declaring an emergency.</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-18</p>	<p>An Ordinance adopting the Village of Sunbury electric aggregation plan of operation and governance pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4928.20 entitled “Electric Aggregation Program Sunbury, Ohio Plan of Operations and Governance” and declaring an emergency.</p>
<p>Ordinance 2012-19</p>	<p>An Ordinance establishing a three-way stop at the intersection of Sunbury Meadows Drive and Mill run Drive and approving installation of all necessary traffic control devices and establishing penalties for violations.</p>

ORDINANCE 2012-20	An Ordinance amending Chapter 181.10(a) of the Village of Sunbury Income Tax Code to reduce interest on unpaid taxes to eight percent (8%) per year in addition to a penalty of fifteen percent (15%) of the tax due.
ORDINANCE 2012-21	An Ordinance authorizing execution of a tax authority portal member agreement with the Regional Income Tax Authority (R.I.T.A.) to provide a remote network connection between the Village of Sunbury and R.I.T.A.'s private network.
ORDINANCE 2012-22	An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute a renewal agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Division of Wildlife for provision of a fisheries management program at the Village of Sunbury up ground reservoirs for a four (4) year term.
