

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF SUNBURY FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2014

Ordinance 2014-01	An Ordinance setting the 2014 Annual Appropriations.
Ordinance 2014-02	An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of notes in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$2,277,400 in anticipation of the issuance of bonds for the purpose of paying the costs of various public infrastructure projects.
Ordinance 2014-03	An Ordinance amending Sunbury Codified Ordinance 139.20 to allow vacation time to be credited as time worked for calculation of overtime earned and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2014-04	An Ordinance amending positions and pay ranges for employees of the Village of Sunbury to add ten additional part-time seasonal maintenance workers and repealing prior ordinance 2009-32.
Ordinance 2014-05	An Ordinance amending Codified Ordinance 139.261 (a) establishing employee co-payments of single employee \$10, employee plus spouse \$20, and family \$30 for the Village of Sunbury health insurance benefits program and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2014-06	An Ordinance approving the application and plan review and zoning certificate of Connells Furniture with conditions and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance 2014-07	An Ordinance establishing a Board of Review to approve amendments or changes to tax regulations and to hear taxpayer appeals and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2014-08	An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of two police cruisers pursuant to O.R.C. 125.04(c) and the purchase of law enforcement outfitting packages for both vehicles at a sum not to exceed \$72,548.00 and further authorizing the execution of all documents associated therewith and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2014-09	An Ordinance providing for the continuing employment of David B. Martin as Village Administrator for an additional 6 month term and authorizing the Mayor to execute a renewal employment contract and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2014-10	An Ordinance authorizing the sale of unneeded, obsolete or unfit personal property with estimated value of \$1000 or more pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 721.15 by public auction and declaring an emergency.
Ordinance 2014-11	An Ordinance approving the execution by the Mayor of an annexation agreement between Geraldine Eder Dye, Domigan Walker, LLC and Northgate Centre Development, LLC regarding 128.2± acres of real estate and declaring and emergency.
