

The city of Sunbury, in coordination with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), is planning improvements along East Granville Street. Improvements will address pedestrian and motorist safety concerns along State Route 37 (E. Granville Street), as well as connecting the Ohio to Erie Trail (OTET). The project is tentatively scheduled to be constructed beginning in September 2027.

To ensure the proposed project is viable and successful, we are asking all those interested to attend and participate in an open house on **Wednesday, June 25** from **5:00-7:00 p.m.** at the **Sunbury Historic Town Hall** located at **51 E. Cherry Street**.
