

# SUNBURY MAYOR'S COURT WAIVER AMOUNTS

## 1<sup>st</sup> Speed/Assured Clear Distance Ahead within Calendar Year

1-15 mph over the limit / ACDA	\$135
16-29 mph over the limit	\$160
30+ mph over the limit	\$185
1+ mph over the limit in School Zone	\$185

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Speed/Assured Clear Distance Ahead within Calendar Year

1-15 mph over the limit / ACDA	\$160
16-29 mph over the limit	\$185
30+ mph over the limit	\$210
1+ mph over the limit in School Zone	\$210

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Speed/Assured Clear Distance Ahead within Calendar Year

Officer Discretion – May be mandatory appearance in court

1-15 mph over the limit / ACDA	\$185
16-29 mph over the limit	\$210
30+ mph over the limit	\$235
1+ mph over the limit in School Zone	\$235

### Per Ohio Law, you must provide proof of insurance.

If you fail to provide adequate proof of insurance covering the operation of vehicle **at the time of the offense** to the officer or Clerk of Court's office, your license will be suspended by the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles. If you are required to appear in court, you must bring proof of insurance with you. An insurance bill is not sufficient proof of insurance.

You may appear in court on your scheduled court date set forth on the ticket to enter a not guilty or no contest plea – OR – you may plead guilty in advance by signing the back of the ticket and enclosing it with payment of the predetermined amount as set forth on the reverse side of this form. This is called paying a waiver of court and you give up your right to appear in court. You must either waive court appearance prior to the court date or appear in court. A continuance of two weeks may be requested in writing either by US Mail, FAX or email the day PRIOR to your court date. Continuances are granted based on circumstances of your case and are **not guaranteed**. If you have any question, please call the clerk or bailiff. Time to pay may be granted by appearing in court.

Personal checks are acceptable from Delaware County Ohio residents only. All other payments must be in cash, certified check, money order or credit/debit card. The court must receive your payment 24 hours prior in advance of your court date. All payments must be made payable to The City of Sunbury.

**Failure to pay the waiver or appear on your court date may result in a warrant for your arrest and/or suspension of your driver's license.**

## Traffic Safety Program (TSP), License Assistance Program (LAP) and Distracted Driving Program (DDP)

If you received a citation for a **waiverable traffic offense** you may be eligible for the Traffic Safety Program (TSP).



Traffic Safety Program Application

If you received a citation for **Driving Under Suspension or No Operator's License** you may be eligible for the License Assistance Program (LAP). Additional information on LAP eligibility can be found on the Mayor's Court website.



License Assistance Program Application

If you received a citation for **Distracted Driving (texting while driving)** you may be eligible to complete a distracted driving course through the Department of Public Safety in lieu of paying a fine.



Distracted Driving Program Application

To apply for TSP, LAP or DDP scan the appropriate QR code and complete the application **prior to** your scheduled court date. If you do not have access to the internet contact the Court directly to discuss your eligibility. Once a completed application is received and reviewed a representative from the Court will contact you to discuss the next steps.
