**Litter and Recycling** — your resource for recycling drop off locations, curbside recycling options and special collection events (electronics, tires, paint, hazardous waste, paper shredding).

**Clinical Services** — adult & child immunizations and health screenings.

**Sewage Treatment Systems (STS)** — individual sewage systems must operate properly and are being phased into an operation and maintenance program. To view records on your property visit [addresssearch.delawarehealth.org](http://addresssearch.delawarehealth.org).

**Naloxone Program** — free to residents unable to afford Naloxone through their health insurance.

**Car Seat Safety Checks** — safety checks for all residents. Free car seats to those who qualify.

**Rabies Prevention** — investigation of animal bites and scratches.

**Community Health Assessment and Improvement** — continually assessing the health of the community, identifying health risks, and determining evidence-based strategies to improve the health of the community.

**Prenatal and Newborn Home Visiting** — free and available to any expecting mother & newborn.

**Mosquito Control** — disease testing in mosquitoes, fogging for disease prevention and free treatment of standing water.

**Water Sampling** — sampling available for wells, cisterns, springs or ponds. Fees apply.

**Food & Pool Inspections** — food & pool inspection reports available at [addresssearch.delawarehealth.org](http://addresssearch.delawarehealth.org)

**Communicable Disease** — investigation, education and response to disease outbreaks.

**Community Coalitions** — consider joining one of our coalitions that focus on a variety of health issues such as tobacco prevention, chronic disease prevention, healthcare, traffic safety and litter prevention.

**Nuisances** — for environmental complaints call 740-203-2070 for investigation.

**WIC** — Supplemental food program for eligible pregnant, post-partum and nursing women, as well as children ages 0-5.

**Birth Certificates** — available for anyone born in Ohio by walk-in, phone or mail order. Fees apply.




